Shelley says: "I love the transparency and luminosity of watercolor. It's something that is unique to only watercolor. Every subject presents new challenges and pushes me to try new techniques and different methods. Many years of experimentation (and yes, lots of failures) have taught me to use quality materials and plan ahead as watercolors are less-forgiving than other mediums. Every success is a real triumph though and I love to share what I've learned with other painters."

"Light is a crucial element in almost everything I paint. For me, it's the life of the painting. I always strive to have interesting lighting in my work and try to create it through the application of subtle glazes and deep rich shadows."
