I am also a Certified Zentangle® Teacher. My artwork has been shown in Pennsylvania, New Jersey, Washington DC, Maryland and Virginia.”

Susan says: “I am inspired by moments that give me peace and serenity. Especially those times when I have been stopped in my day by a play of colors, a blend of textures, or a juxtaposition of natural forms. Watercolor is my preferred medium because I enjoy the movement of pigments in the water and how that mirrors the movement of color through air.”
