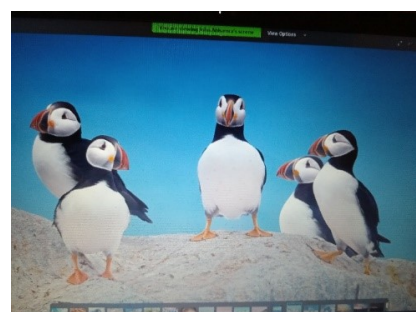
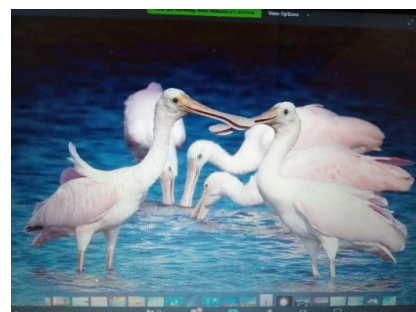
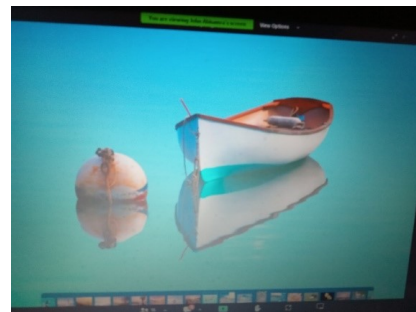
Artist's Statement

Sometimes it's pure joy in the moment, and sometimes it's a relief from troubling times. No matter the circumstances, the feeling of those colorful chunks of pure pigment against the surface of my paper allow my intuition to combine with years of experience to either provide me with a learning experience or a finished work of art that I can be proud of. Because my intent from the start is an emotional one, my hope is that my finished piece can evoke a similar response in the viewer."

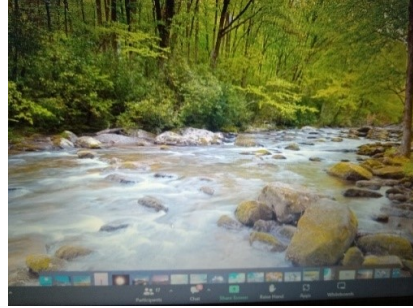


Re-Cap of September's Demo with Photographer John Abisamra

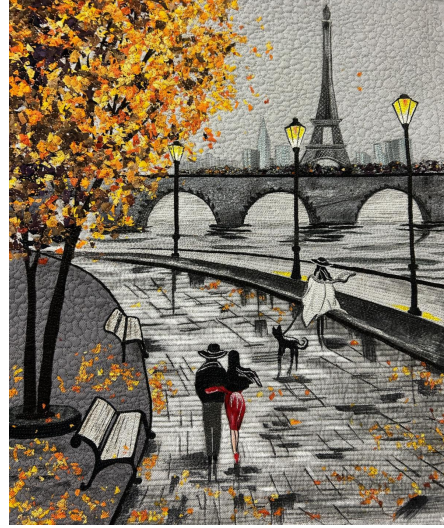
Happy Birthday, Helen Gangi

Two Lynnfield Art Guild Members Accepted into the Lexington Gallery Twist Pairings Show

The Lynnfield Art Guild is proud to announce that two of its members have had work accepted into the prestigious Gallery Twist Pairings Show. LAG artists Beverly Cook and Jeannette Corbett are two of the artists chosen from the over one thousand entrants for the September 22 – October 15, 2023 show at Gallery Twist, 1963 Massachusetts Avenue, Lexington.

Beverly Cook is an award-winning painter/quilter active in the Reading, Rockport and Lynnfield, MA Art Guilds and Studio Art Quilt

Associates. Beverly has won numerous ribbons for her acrylic, watercolor, fabric paintings and quilts, prizes for “People’s Choice” and “Best in Show” Awards and is the first recipient of the Mary Saia Memorial Award in Reading. Several of her fiber works were first painted by Beverly in either watercolor or acrylic, then recreated in a quilting-like process that includes the use of fiber, embroidery threads, and dryer sheets. Three of Beverly Cook’s unique artworks will be exhibited: **"The Fleet's In"** is a rhythmic meditation of free-motion stitching creating the sky, water, reflections, and weathered vessels against the chaos of the rigging. **"Love Light"** shows a pair of lovers walking along the Seine and the Eiffel Tower, illustrating Paris’ two nicknames: The City of Love and The City of Lights. **"Red (Rain/Shine)"** shows a red figure ambling toward the “shine.”

Jeannette Corbett is an award-winning artist whose work can be found in corporate, public, and private collections throughout New England. Jeannette has received art instruction from Tom Sutherland, Monique Sakellarios, and Teri Eramo and, in the past 10 years, has received over 150

awards, including twelve Best in Shows. Jeannette's landscape paintings are particularly influenced by her travels throughout France and Italy. Wildflower fields, expansive skies, and medieval villages have become central images. In this exhibit, her paintings **"Long Ago and Far Away"** and **"Ruby and Emerald Field"** are revisitations of timeless Italian landscapes.

The Gallery Twist is open to the public from 11 am – 5 pm Wednesday to Sunday and the artwork can be viewed online beginning September

22nd at www.gallerytwist.com. The Guild is proud of its members' successes and invites the public to visit the Guild's

The Guild's annual art show will be held on Saturday November 4 from 10 – 4 in the Meeting House on the Lynnfield Common. 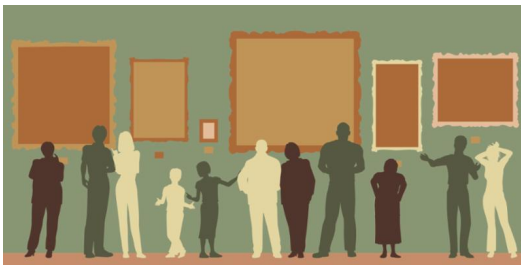
