Hello everyone! Heidi here, with another update on our ongoing community projects!

Public Art Grant Recipient

As the Director of Community Engagement for the Lynnfield Art Guild, we have applied for and received a generous grant from the Lynnfield Cultural Council to continue facilitating

the growth of public art in Lynnfield. My studio, <u>Re-create</u>, will have a small studio class lineup this winter while we're out in the community bringing art to you! From the Village Parklet Project to the Window Walk at Market Street, we are finding new ways to engage the community through collaborative projects.

The Free Little Art Gallery

This miniature art gallery has been traveling around Lynnfield! After its debut at the Lynnfield Fall Festival, it traveled to the art room at Huckleberry Hill Elementary School. Students worked on telling their own stories through writing and illustrating their own custom artist books to add to the "permanent collection." We now have over 50 books! The Gallery just moved to the Lynnfield Library where you can read your neighbors' stories and write one of your own.

Summer Window Walk at Market Street

Artists will populate the windows of our local businesses with paintings, sculptures, and photographs. We'll see art from seniors, high schoolers, and everyone in-between. Village Parklet Project

School Murals






"Meet the Artist" Returns Live at Lynnfield Public Library Thursday February 27th


