- Include a brief explanation of the Inspiration behind the work. What inspired you to paint or photograph this particular subject?



Your images will be shared with members of the Village Home & Garden Club at their **March 10th meeting**. At that time, artwork for the show will be selected. Artists will be notified following the selection meeting. If your work of art is selected, you will be notified by email.

The Garden Club recommends that art does not feature flowers as the main theme, however, flowers can be in the work as a secondary theme.

The show schedule is as follows:

- <u>Drop Off</u>: Friday April 11th for Show Set Up. NOTE: If art piece is over-sized, an easel may have to be provided.
- The "Art in Bloom" Opening Reception is Monday April 14, 2025 at 6:30pm at the Lynnfield Public Library.
- <u>Pick Up</u> is after the show ends (late Thursday evening, April 17 or Friday morning, April 18).

Beverly Cook will demonstrate her quilt-like process, which includes

the use of fabric, embroidery threads, sometimes dryer sheets (clouds) or other household finds. Says Beverly, "Batik fabric is a favorite, as it lends nicely to this technique having shading and variations that give a painterly look and value. Rarely is paint used, but not completely disregarded as it can add a dramatic touch where threadwork would be exceedingly difficult."

Come meet Beverly Cook in person to experience the magic of "Painting with Fabric" LIVE at the <u>Al Merritt Center at Market Street in Lynnfield, MA.</u>


