

The Lynnfield Art Guild Presents “An Oil Painting Demo” by Mary Taggart on Nov. 20th via Zoom and In-Person at her Studio

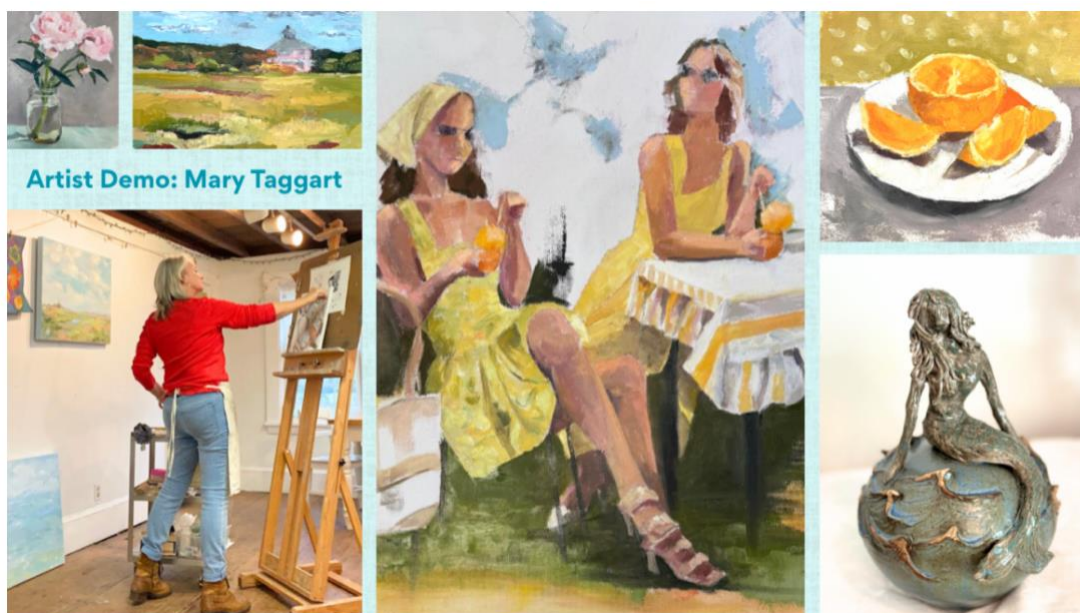
Mary Taggart is a painter from Rowley, MA and the owner of Taggart Studio in Wakefield where she teaches drawing and painting to both children and adults. A graduate of the Massachusetts College of Art, she later studied with many noted painters including Catherine Kehoe and George Nick.

During her career, she taught in both public and private settings, while raising two daughters. She ran a successful mural business before opening Taggart Studio. She also maintains a personal painting studio in Ipswich.

Painting primarily in oils, she paints still lifes in her studio working to create a sense of space with color and value. The challenge for her is the representation of a three-dimensional object on a two-dimensional surface and the invention that comes with that interpretation. She also paints “plein air” at local marshes and beaches. The plein air paintings also serve as the inspiration for larger studio work. In her landscapes, she hopes to convey a sense of space and her deep love of the area. She is interested in the constant change that takes place in nature and that push-pull of the landscape—earth and sky—wind and water, the vast energy of our natural world.

She has exhibited in many group shows and has had several solo shows in the area. Her work has received recognition in area shows, including Best in Show, Best in Oils and Best in Concept. Her work is in many private collections
